The Cook Book Club will share ideas and samples of appetizers at their March 4th meeting. Come join the fun at 1:00 p.m.



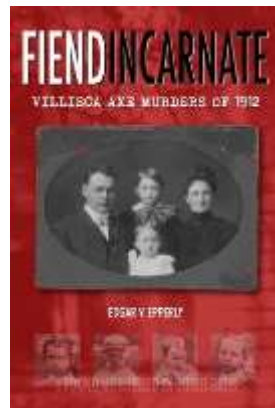

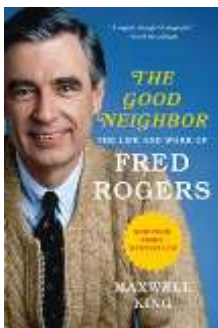
