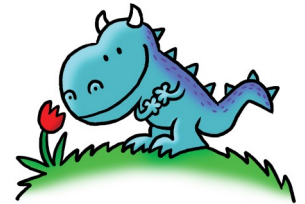
June 1st-30th 2022. Registration begins May 23rd.

Learn the basics of coding with fun & games.

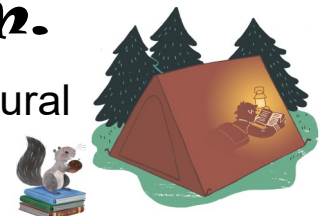
June 22: Art Camp 2:00 p.m.
